AOP Côtes du Roussillon

This Côtes du Roussillon Rouge cuvée is made from Mediterranean grape varieties from thirty-year-old vines, and truly represents the expression of « New world » winegrowers on one of the most beautiful terroirs in France. The elegant label on this bottle traces the Grier Family's story through a stylized illustration of a world map, on which the journey between South Africa and the South of France is indicated.

Grape varieties: Syrah 35 %
Carignan 35 %
Grenache noir 30 %

Terroir: Schistose marls

The vines, cultivated as trellis and gobelets, are harvested at an optimal phenolic maturity in order to guarantee a high quality of tannins and a beautiful elegance of the fruit.

Vinification: After destemming followed by light crushing, the grapes are vatted directly.

Fermentation is then carried out around 26°C and the work of the wine is done by pumping over.

The vatting is more or less long depending on the grape varieties. After pressing and rackling, the wines are blended to achieve malo-lactic fermentation in French oak barrels and then continue their aging for 12 months.

Bottling takes place after one year of aging.

Nose: Beautiful maturity with a nose of remarkable complexity where the oak and the fruit respect each other.

Palate: Develops noble and powerful tannins which, combined with an attractive roundness, give great fullness to the wine.

Analyses :

- Residual sugars: less than 1 g/L
- Total Acidity : 3,34 g/L (H₂SO₄)
- pH : 3,14
